Additional Requirements For Graduation

Training in Emergency Aid, CPR, and the use of AED – Students shall be trained in emergency aid, CPR, and the use of AED, including hands-on practice of the skills necessary to perform such needs.

A student's grade point average (A = 4.00) is computed at the end of the Freshman year. Advanced Placement courses are weighted +1.0. Honors and IBMYP courses are weighted +0.5 in computation of the GPA. A weighted GPA is reported.

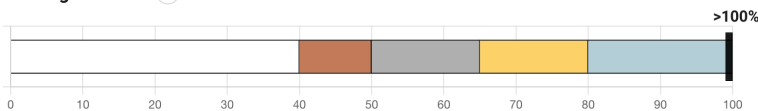
AP Access Award

The 2024 AP School Honor Roll also recognizes Millwood School as providing all students the chance to participate in AP, including students of underrepresented populations.

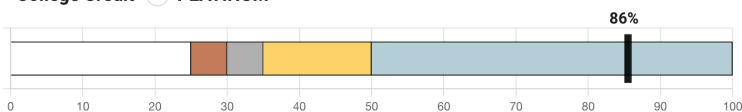

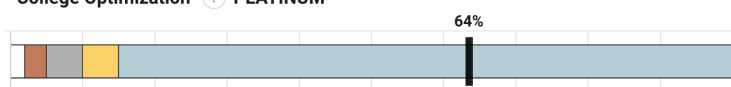
